

## Press Note

18 September 2021

Mumbai Police is well prepared for the Anant Chaturdashi visarjan on 19 September 2021.

Fixed Points and Patrolling will be deployed at all sensitive spots and areas. Heavy bandobast is being deployed at all immersion points. Arrangements such as lighting, cranes, swimmers, ambulance, fire service, and all other safety measures are being undertaken in coordination with the departments concerned. Anti-sabotage measures, Night Patrolling and Good Morning Squad operations will be undertaken with high alertness in this period. Vital installations will be safe guarded.

Maximum manpower at all Police Stations and Branches will be deployed for bandobast duties. Extra Manpower is being deployed in the form of:

- 100 officers and 1500 men from Local Arms and various branches
- 3 Company of SRPF
- 1 Company of CRPF
- 500 Home Guards
- 275 Constables from outside units

An All Out Operation was held on night of 17-18 September to crack down on criminal activities. Nakabandi and combing operations were undertaken; checking of criminals on record, hotels and lodges, vital installations and sensitive locations was undertaken, cases were made against illicit activities including drugs, illegal arms, illicit liquor, drunken driving, etc.

Meetings have been taken with Ganpati mandals, peace committees, mohalla committees and all stakeholders and appropriate instructions were been given for a peaceful visarjan.
