

THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE, GREATER MUMBAI  
ORDER  
(UNDER SECTION 144 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE, 1973)

1. Whereas, in exercise of powers conferred under Section 2 of the Epidemic Diseases Act 1897 read with enabling provisions of the National Disaster Management Act 2005, the Government of Maharashtra issued directions vide Notification No. DMU/2020/CR.92/DisM-1, Dated: 13th April 2021 ("Break the Chain") to take certain emergency measures to prevent and contain the spread of Covid-19 virus and to enforce these measures throughout the state,
2. Whereas, the Government of Maharashtra issued directions vide Notification No. DMU/2020/CR.92/DisM-1, Dated: 21<sup>st</sup> April 2021, 29<sup>th</sup> April 2021, 12<sup>th</sup> May 2021, 30<sup>th</sup> May 2021, 04<sup>th</sup> June 2021 and 25<sup>th</sup> June 2021, to continue emergency measures to prevent and contain the spread of Covid-19 virus and to extend the restrictions that have been imposed from time to time, along with all additions and clarifications issued thereof, to break the chain of transmission of Covid-19 virus effectively,
3. Whereas, the Government of Maharashtra has, vide Notification No: Corona 2021/C.R.366/Arogya-5, Dated: 02 August 2021, issued modifications to the currently imposed restrictions, allowing Disaster Management Authorities of the districts Mumbai, Mumbai Suburban and Thane to take a decision regarding reducing the currently imposed restrictions, and the Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai (MCGM), which is the Disaster Management Authority for Greater Mumbai, consequently released a circular No. MGC/G/4967, Dated: 02 August 2021, issuing modifications to the currently imposed restrictions;
4. **THEREFORE, I, Chaitanya. S. , Dy. Commissioner of Police (Operations), Greater Mumbai, and Executive Magistrate, vide powers conferred upon me u/sec 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 (Act II of 1974) r/w the order of Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai, dated 23/12/1959 u/s 10 sub section (2) of the Maharashtra Police Act, 1951 (Mah. Act XXII of 1951), as I am satisfied that Greater Mumbai continues to be threatened with the spread of Covid-19 virus and it is imperative to continue with emergency measures to prevent and contain the spread of virus, with a view to prevent danger to human life, health or safety, and to break the chain of transmission of virus effectively, do hereby promulgate an order under section 144 Criminal Procedure Code, to observe the directions of the Government of Maharashtra issued vide Notification No. Corona 2021/C.R.366/Arogya-5, Dated: 02 Aug 2021, along with all additions and clarifications issued thereof, and certain regulations framed for effective containment of Covid-19 pandemic, and prohibit violation of the same.**
5. This order shall come into force, in the areas under the control of the Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai, with effect from 00.00 Hrs on 04<sup>th</sup> August 2021 and will remain in force till 24.00 Hrs on 31<sup>th</sup> August 2021, unless withdrawn earlier. The order u/s 144 CrPC, Dated 30<sup>th</sup> July 2021, issued by the undersigned is hereby withdrawn.

6. Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code 1860 in addition to penal provisions under the Epidemic Diseases Act 1897 and National Disaster Management Act 2005 and other legal provisions as applicable.

7. As the notice cannot be served individually on all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of the Public, through the Press, or by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the Police Stations and offices of the Divisional ACsP and Zonal DCsP.
