

## ORDER

CP/XI (6)/A.P./701(07)/2020

WHEREAS based on the declaration issued by World Health Organization on 11/03/2020 characterizing the outbreak of COVID-19, a global pandemic and the subsequent notifications issued by Government of India and Government of Maharashtra under the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, it is apprehended that there is danger to human health or safety or a disturbance of the public tranquility. AND, it is considered expedient to issue prohibitory order for restricting movement and unlawful assembly of five or more persons for prevention of danger to human health or safety or a disturbance of the public tranquility and to prevent any kind of riot or affray in the areas under the control of Commissioner of Police, Brihan Mumbai.

2. NOW, THEREFORE, I **Pranaya Ashok, Dy. Commissioner of Police (Operations), Brihan Mumbai** in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sub section (3) of section 37 read with sub section (2) of section 10 of the Maharashtra Police Act, 1951 (Mah. Act XXII of 1951), do hereby prohibit, for the period commencing **from 00.01 hours on 12/04/2020 and ending at 24.00 hours on 14/04/2020 through the City of Brihan Mumbai,**

- i) Any assembly of five or more persons,
- ii) Any procession of any persons and
- iii) Any use of loudspeakers, amplifying instruments, musical band and bursting of crackers in any procession by the assembly.

This order does not apply to the following exempted entities:

- i.) Emergency Services;
- ii.) Establishments providing essential Services like:
  - a. Food, vegetables, milk supplies, ration and grocery stores;
  - b. Hospitals, medicines, pharma and related establishments, pathology laboratories, medical/nursing colleges;
  - c. Telephone & internet services;
  - d. Electricity, petroleum, oil and energy related;
  - e. Banking, Stock Exchange, Clearing Corporations, Depositories, Stock Brokers and SEBI registered participants operating these instruments;
  - f. IT and IT enabled services and Data Centers providing services for Critical National and International Infrastructure and needed for above essential and emergency services;
  - g. Media;
  - h. Port;
  - i. Services providing home delivery of food, groceries and essential commodities;
  - j. Drinking water supply and maintenance;
  - k. Godowns and warehousing related to the above;
  - l. Trucks/Tempos carrying goods and manpower related to the above services.
- iii.) Government/semi-government agencies and their officials on duty;
- iv.) The Zonal DCsP, in emergent/special cases are empowered to grant exemption.

3. Notwithstanding the expiration of this order after the period here in above mentioned.
- (a) Any investigation or legal proceeding may be instituted, continued or enforced.
  - (b) Any penalty, forfeiture of punishments incurred in respect of any contravention of this order may be imposed as if this order had not expired.


**I further direct that this order will be published and promulgated in Brihan Mumbai by affixing copies thereof, in conspicuous part public of places, courts, Govt Offices and by**
