THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE, GREATER MUMBAI ORDER (U/ S 144 OF CRPC -1973)

Whereas reports have been received that due to the situation prevailing in the areas under the control of Commissioner of Police, Brihan Mumbai, it is noticed that flying balloons, high riser crackers, release of light objects, kites etc are sent in and around the approach of runways and the Laser Light Beams are flashed towards the direction of the landing aircraft, in the Free Flight Zone Around Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport area thereby endangering the Safety of Flights in the said Area.

- 2. And whereas it is necessary that some check should be put on the flying of paragliders and sending of balloons, high riser crackers, release of light objects, kites and usage of Laser Beam illumination and establishing a Laser Beam Free Flight Zone around Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport so that usage of paragliders, balloons, high riser crackers, release of light objects, kites Laser Beams should not affect Aircraft landing, take off and Aircraft flying operations and that immediate action is necessary for the prevention of the same.
- 3. Now, therefore I, Pranaya Ashok, Dy. Commissioner of Police, (Operations), Greater Mumbai and Executive Magistrate, vide powers conferred upon me u./sec 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code 1973 (Act II of 1974) r/w the Commissioner of Police Brihan Mumbai's Order dated 23/12/1959 u/s 10 sub section (2) of the Maharashtra Police Act 1951 (Mah. Act XXII of 1951) do hereby order that,
- A} in the jurisdiction of Mumbai Police Commissioner, No person shall use paragliders, send ballons, high riser crackers, release of light objects, kites and Laser Beam in Free Flight Zone around Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport.
- B) Any person or individual who notices such type of activities being used with the intent to obstruct landing, take off and flying operations of any aircraft shall inform the nearest Police Station.
- 4. This order shall come into force with effect from 20/06/2020 and shall be effective for a period of 60 days up to 18/08/2020 (both days inclusive) unless withdrawn earlier.
- 5. Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.
- 6. As the notice cannot be served individually on all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public, through press, and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the police stations, Divisional ACsP, Zonal DCsP, Municipal Ward offices and by affixing copies at Tahsil and Ward offices.
